

Adopt A Highway Clean Up Day

Location:

Airport Road from the intersection with South Hwy 99 going two miles west, to the small bridge. There is a sign on both ends indicating this section is maintained by the First United Methodist Church

Parking is available in a small gravel lot on the south (left) side of Airport Road a little ways in from Hwy 99; carpooling is encouraged

Equipment:

Provided by Benton County: large yellow plastic bags, caution signs for start, finish, and mid points; safety vests, 'grabbers' (This equipment is arranged by church contact person)

Bring your own: clothing and footwear for the weather, drinking water, work gloves, hat

Safety first

- Stay well off the roadway. Vehicles travel fast on this road.
- Watch your footing. There are steep ditch banks and slippery mud when wet
- Don't get cut on sharp glass or metal - use a grabber or strong gloves, or leave it

For the most creation friendly results, carry two bags and put recyclables in one and put landfill trash in the other. Bring the recyclables back to a recycling cart at church or home. Leave the landfill trash bags there for the county crews to pick up.

Enjoy the fresh air, bird songs (including meadowlarks), and company of friends as you walk along
